Incentives under the scheme:

- 1) **Annual Scholarship (K1):** Unmarried girls of age 13 to 18 years from families with annual income upto ₹1,20,000 enrolled in any educational or vocational institute will get annual scholarship of ₹750 per annum.
- 2) **One Time Grant (K2):** Unmarried girls of age 18 to 19 years from families with annual income upto ₹1,20,000 enrolled in any educational, vocational or sports institute will get one time grant of ₹25,000.
